



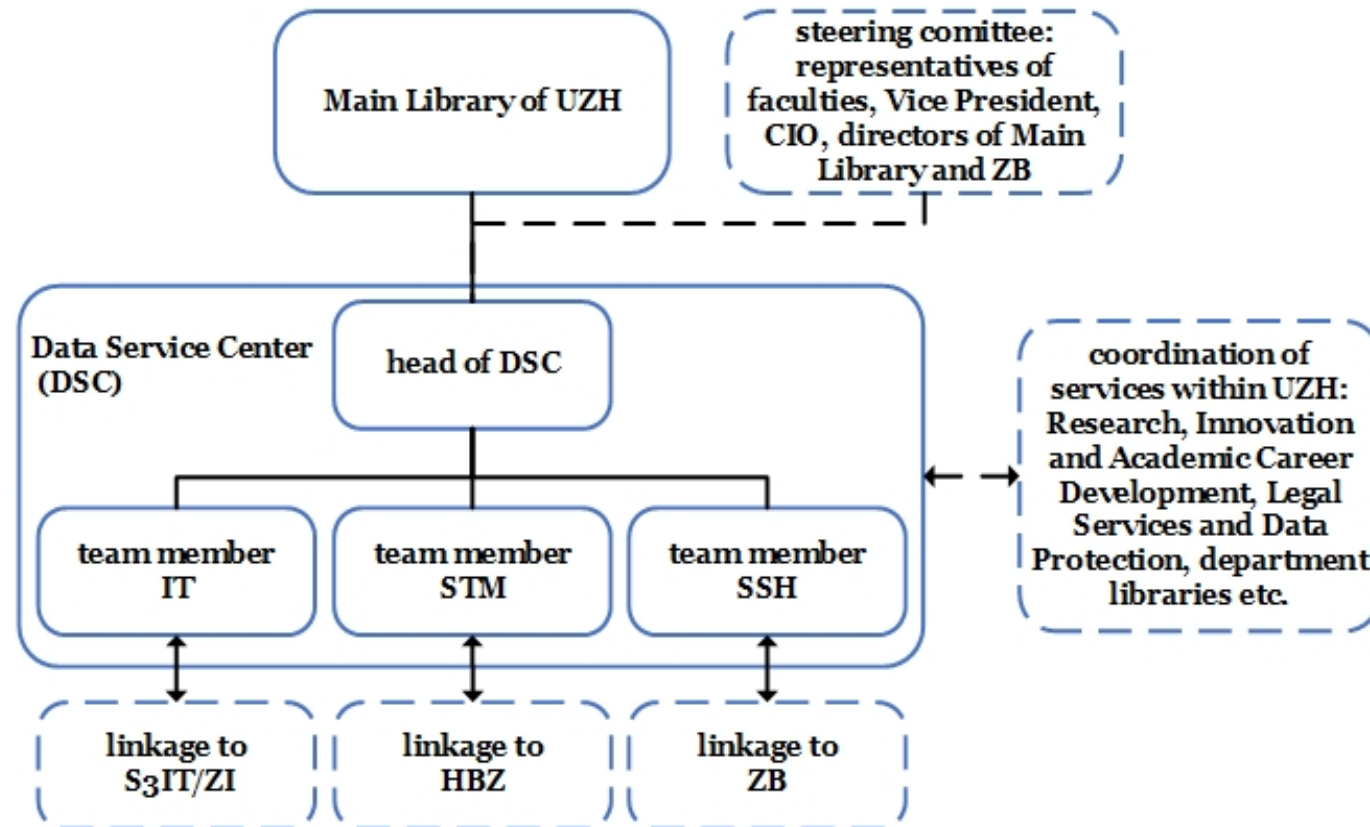
## Developing a Data Service Center (DSC) for UZH

### Background and starting points

- growing amount of research data, reproducibility crisis
- research funders require data management plans (DMPs) to ensure transparency and reuse of data (SNF since Oct. 2017)
- growing importance of access to research networks and infrastructures (for example CLARIN for linguistic research, FORS for Social Sciences etc.)
- need of repository solution to store and publish data
- lack of legal certainty
- engagement of many LERU universities in different aspects of research data management
- Executive Board of UZH approved development of DSC in February 2018 (cooperation of Main Library, S3IT and Zentralbibliothek Zürich)

### Information and support

- Compliancy with FAIR principles
- Support for writing data management plans (DMPs)
- Organisation of training courses related to relevant topics (WORKSHOP: “Design your Data Management Plan for the SNSF” on 28 August 2018 – Graduate Campus)

### Coordination

- coordination support for disciplinary initiatives (e.g. data storage, Digital Editions)
- UZH-wide coordination of central services related to research data management (Legal Services, Data Protection, Research, Innovation and Academic Career Development etc.)
- National coordination tasks (swissuniversities P-5, SAGW, DaSCH)
